Plaintiff's motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff shall cause service of the Summons to Unknown Defendants ("Notice") in the form attached as Exhibit 2 to the Affidavit of Counsel filed in support of the motion to be made in accordance with subdivisions (d)(10) and (e) of Rule 4 of the Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, as follows:

1. The Clerk of Court (or Deputy Clerk) is directed to sign and date the Notice and affix the Trial Court seal and return same to Plaintiff's counsel;
2. Plaintiff shall cause the Notice to be posted on the Alaska Court System's legal notice website continuously for four consecutive weeks;
3. Plaintiff shall cause the Notice to be published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the *Alaska Journal of Commerce*, the *Mat-Su Valley Frontiersman* and the *Alaska Dispatch News*; and
4. Following posting of the Notice as provided in paragraph 1 above and publication of the Notice as provided in paragraph 2 above, Plaintiff shall file proof of service on the unknown defendants as required by subdivision (e) (6) (A) and (B) of Rule 4 of the Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure.
